There are two School Sessions each day:

Morning 9 am to 12.00 noon

Afternoon 1.00 pm to 3.15 pm

We open the school gates at 8.45 am and we are always there to greet you and answer any questions you may have. The school runs a breakfast club should you need to send your child earlier than this. The bell will ring at 8.55 am to tell the children to say good-bye and settle into class and then again at 9 am for the start of registration.
