

## School Meals



We run a Breakfast Club every morning from 8 am in the school hall. It is run by two TA's and the children can just turn up, you do not need to pre book. Further information on Breakfast Club can be found on the website or by contacting the office.

We encourage you to take advantage of our school meals, which are free to all children in Penguins and Robins classes. Children in Owls and Eagles class can purchase a meal or bring in a packed lunch.

We teach the children about healthy eating to support sensible choices from the varied menu. Our mealtimes are social occasions and we encourage good table manners. Facilities are provided for those wishing to bring a packed lunch (in a named lunch box please).

Would you please send all dinner money to school on MONDAY each week, even if your child is only staying for one meal later in the week. If you feel your child may qualify for free school dinners throughout their time at the school, please ask, in confidence, at the school office.

As Health Education is part of our curriculum should you choose to send in a packed lunch we ask you to ensure that your child has a healthy balanced lunch and drink.

We have a team of experienced mid-day supervisors who care for the children at lunchtime.

In addition to a drink for lunchtime (which should be in a named plastic flask) we also suggest that each child brings a named, clear plastic bottle of water to drink in class time. This should have a "sports top". Every morning each child in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 is given a piece of fresh fruit as part of the school Fruit Scheme.
