

Communication



A newsletter goes home every Friday. The headteacher writes one each fortnight, and in the intervening weeks newsletters are written by the Friends and by the school council (children of the school). All letters, newsletters and policies are available on the school website.

There is a notice board beside the entrance for up and coming events and we anticipate introducing a text information service in the near future.

Assembly takes place every day, with whole school assemblies on Monday, Tuesday and Fridays. There are frequent invitations to parents for Friday assemblies.

We ask you to always report to the school office if you come into the school during the day for any reason. If you are helping in school you will need to sign in and out at the office and wear a badge identifying you as a parent helper. If you bring your child into school late, please report to the office.

If you have to collect your child from school for an appointment for medical or dental treatment, please let us know in advance and on the day call at the school office to meet your child.

Accidents can happen and although we have first aiders who can deal with minor cuts and bruises we prefer to contact you and to seek specialist help for more serious accidents. It is most important, therefore, that you leave up to date emergency phone numbers with us in case we need to contact you quickly if your child is unwell or has had an accident.

We try to send messages to you either by email, letter or telephone. Please send your messages to us in the same way, as young children especially, cannot always be relied upon to carry verbal messages correctly.
