

# Admissions



We follow the Cambridgeshire Admission Policy. During the summer term we hold an open afternoon for new Reception parents to provide information about the school. The afternoon also offers an opportunity for parents to speak to the Reception teacher.

We admit up to 17 children. The teacher and support staff work as a team to provide the best for the children.

You are most welcome to visit the school before applying for a place for your child if they are of Reception age or older. Please contact the office if you wish to make an appointment and to find out more information about the school.

Applications for a place at Gorefield are made through the local authority.

If you are unsure how to go about this, please visit the school office and ask how you may register your child for admission to our school and will help you through the procedure.

We follow the Cambridgeshire guidelines for over subscription. This currently uses the following criteria:-

- 1) Children in catchment
- 2) Children out of catchment but with siblings
- 3) Out of catchment
